Synopsis

Camille Lowman sent two emails containing information and attachments that she feels are relevant to this investigation, including allegations of additional charges.

Narrative

On Monday, January 5, 2026, Camille Lowman sent an email to Chief Price, OSPI, members of the Attorney General's Office, the ESD 112 superintendent, the mayor of Vancouver, and I containing information that she believed was relevant to this investigation. The email contained an attachment titled, "2nd f Dec of Camille L with Ex.pdf."

Later that day, she sent a second email, stating, in part:

Please see the attached for the other (4) declarations (Adam Aguilera, Danny Stevenson, Tim Siess, and Katie Rich) that I referenced in my prior email. I have also re-attached my declaration from my previous email for ease of reference, and have included Exhibit 11 -- the documentation of billings approved by Jenae Gomes from Garrett Williams of Stevens Clay.

The second email contained five attachments, titled:

- 2. 12 11 25 Dec for Danny Stevenson with exhibits - Signed.pdf
- 3. Declaration of Katie Rich- 12_9_25.pdf
- 4. Signed Declaration of Tim Siess and exhibit.pdf

- 6. Exhibit 11 July 2024 to June 2025 Stevens Clay.pdf

In the emails, Ms. Lowman alleged that, "on October 28, 2025, [Evergreen School District Attorney] Garrett Williams was asked questions by VPD Jay Alie which were material to his investigation efforts and that Garrett Williams provided false or misleading information to Jay Alie."

Ms. Lowman also alleged that payments to Mr. Williams' law firm were not, "publicly approved by the ESD Board in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements."

Ms. Lowman continued:

I have previously indicated that Garrett Williams' actions in the October 28, 2025 email to VPD Jay Alie constituted sufficient evidence of the crime of providing false or misleading statements to a public servant. However, it is clear that Garrett Williams' false and misleading statements were not approved by the ESD Board member Gary Wilson. There is no record that payment by the ESD was publicly approved by the ESD Board in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements.

There appears to be more than sufficient evidence to justify an investigation into the crime of misappropriation of public funds, (See; RCW 42.20.070; Misappropriation and falsification of accounts by public officer) relating to the October payments authorized by Ms. Gomes for Garrett Wilson's representation of her personal criminal defense. Specifically, for the representation encompassing the provision of false or misleading material statements to VPD Det. Jay Alie. (See: RCW 9A.76.175). It would appear that investigation of these crimes may need to be undertaken by a different law enforcement agency as VPD Det. Jay Alie was the victim of one of these crimes, i.e. the allegations of the violation of RCW 9A.76.175.
